

PhD in Medical Sciences - Checklist - official Requirements

The time limit is 3 years from the date of admission.

First Step

- Admission to the PhD programme

Extension of the doctoral time on request.

Enrollment at HHU

- as doctoral researcher or doctoral auditing researcher
- remain enrolled until Doctoral Certificate is issued

Auditing doctoral researchers will not be reminded about re-enrolling deadlines.

Structured Training Programme (Yes, it's mandatory!)

- Good scientific Practice for PhD in Medical Sciences
- min. 2 days in Science: Basics & Beyond
- min. 2 days in Career Development & Self-Management
- min. 2 days in Didactics: Learning & Teaching
- min. 10 workshop days in total
- active Participation in a Congress/Symposium w/ Poster or Talk
- min. 15 Guest Lectures
- min. 100 hours of Lectures and Seminars
- min. 100 hours of Advanced Workshops and Trainings

In total, the Basic and Cluster Curriculum add up to approx. 300 hours.
