

Structured training program Medical Research School

By registering the doctoral project at the medRSD, the doctoral students are obliged to participate in the medRSD training program. The training program must be completed by the submission of the doctoral thesis. After successful completion of your doctoral project and the Structured training program you will receive a confirmation from us. Without these, the submission of the doctoral thesis is not possible.

For successful participation, the following accomplishments must be provided:

Good Scientific Practice

Compulsory participation in continuing education for Good Scientific Practice. No event days will be credited for this course.

Congress participation

Mandatory and active participation in a congress with a poster or a lecture. Doctoral candidates who do not have the opportunity to attend a major conference can present their research findings at the medRSD annual Symposium. Institute or clinic events do not count as congress participation. No event days will be credited for the participation in a congress.

Core competencies and key qualifications

In total you need 6 days of participation:

- 2 days must be gained from the area of core competencies
- 2 days from the area of key qualifications
- 2 days are of free choice

The area to which an event belongs is indicated in the course overview.

Crediting of event days

In individual cases, external events can also be recognized. The prerequisite for this is that they fit into the training program of the medRSD and have been evaluated. Institute or clinic events such as Doctoral seminars or animal experiment courses are not counted.
